Beginning July 1, 2010, all applicants for a new pharmacy technician registration, and renewal of a pharmacy technician registration shall provide proof of current national pharmacy technician certification and shall complete the application for certified pharmacy technician registration.

All certified technicians will also need to complete specified Continuing Education requirements to renew and keep their certifications. These classes are designed to both help working technicians review for the national testing, and also offer CE credit to certified technicians who might want to review any of the material.
