

A.A. Degree Requirements

The Associate in Arts transfer degree is designed to provide the first two years of a typical college or university bachelor's degree program in liberal arts, general education or pre-professional studies. By earning this degree, you'll have met the general requirements at several area colleges and universities. Work with your advisor for recommended courses within each requirement based on your area of interest.

To earn the Associate in Arts transfer degree, complete the following:

- Earn a minimum of 64 semester credits.
- Earn a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.00 or higher.
- Complete general requirements, totaling 40 or more semester credits.
