



ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS



IOWA LAKES

MANAGEMENT

Students seeking admission into the Aviation program at Iowa Lakes Community College must meet the following entrance requirements:

Requirements & Official Documents

- ☐ Acceptance to Iowa Lakes Community College
All applicants must first be accepted as a student at Iowa Lakes Community College by completing the general application process.
- ☐ Completion of the Aviation Letter of Intent Form
Prospective aviation students must complete and submit the Aviation Letter of Intent Form to indicate their interest in the program.
- ☐ Submission of Required Citizenship Status Documents
To comply with federal regulations, students must provide the following documents as proof of U.S. citizenship or legal residency:
 - Birth Certificate
 - Passport (if applicable)
 - State Issued Driver's License
- ☐ TSA Approval Form (International Students)
Students must complete and submit the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) approval form to be eligible for flight training, as required under federal aviation security regulations.
- ☐ FAA Medical Exam
Students must obtain and submit a valid First or Second Class FAA Medical Certificate from an FAA-authorized aviation medical examiner.

Academic Requirements

- ☐ Applicants must meet one of the following academic criteria:
 - Previous degree from an accredited post-secondary institution.
 - Transfer Students: Transcript GPA of 2.5 or higher
 - Unweighted High School GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - ACT Score of 19 or above
 - SAT Score of 925 or above
 - ASVAB Score of 50 or above

Physical Stature Requirement

- ☐ Due to aircraft weight limitations, students must not exceed a maximum body weight of 260 pounds.

All required documents and qualifications must be met before a student can enroll in aviation courses or participate in flight training. Failure to meet these requirements may result in delays, placement into a probationary term, or denial of enrollment in the Aviation program.
